- 1 Honoring the memory of Francis Marian Mitchell; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Francis Marian Mitchell was born on January 28, 1825, in Georgia and married
- 3 Clementine Stuart in 1850; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Francis Marian Mitchell was inducted into the Confederate Infantry Co. I
- 5 Regiment 20th on March 1, 1863, in Richmond, Virginia; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he and his wife had 11 children: Mary, Henry, James, Sarah, Rhoda, Jackson,
- 7 Elizabeth, Margaret, Georgia, Charley, and Jesse; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Francis Marian Mitchell owned a farm and mill at the intersection of Burnt
- 9 Hickory Road and Mitchell Mill Road, was one of the founders of Pleasant Hill Church in
- 10 Douglas County, served as coroner of Douglas County, and was a member of the Masonic
- 11 Lodge; and
- 12 WHEREAS, this great confederate veteran died on January 4, 1913, and it is appropriate to
- 13 honor his memory.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 15 the member of this body honor the memory of confederate war veteran Francis Marian
- 16 Mitchell.
- 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the descendants of Francis
- 19 Marian Mitchell.
