A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Honorable Alvin Arrowood, Mayor of Sharpsburg; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mayor Alvin Arrowood served as Mayor of Sharpsburg from 1986 until his
4 resignation for health reasons on February 1, 2003; and

5 WHEREAS, he served as a town council member from 1972 to 1986; and

6 WHEREAS, as mayor, he oversaw the original design and construction of the A&O Bridges
7 Recreation Center, the tennis facility, the installation of city streetlights, and the 1989
8 expansion and 2002 renovation of the Community Center and Clerk's office; and

9 WHEREAS, for many years when the town numbered less than 200 residents, Mayor
10 Arrowood worked single-handedly in maintaining the Bridges Center, obtaining county
11 assistance for the town, addressing citizen concerns, and providing town representation to
12 the county government, the Chattahoochee-Flint Planning Council, and the Department of
13 Community Affairs; and

14 WHEREAS, Mayor Arrowood is known for his positive attitude and generous spirit, and his
15 leadership, dedication, and service to his community are recognized and applauded by the
16 citizens of Sharpsburg.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 recognize and commend Mayor Arrowood for his many outstanding accomplishments and
19 his important contributions to the State of Georgia.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
21 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Alvin Arrowood.
