

House Bill 157 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 6 of Article 4 of Chapter 5 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia
2 Annotated, relating to coastal management, so as to reestablish or continue such provisions
3 until July 1, 2009; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
4 purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Part 6 of Article 4 of Chapter 5 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
8 relating to coastal management, is amended by striking Code Section 12-5-329, relating to
9 the repeal of Part 6 of Article 4 of Chapter 5 of Title 12, the "Georgia Coastal Management
10 Act," and inserting in its place a new Code Section 12-5-329 to read as follows:

11 "12-5-329.

12 Unless reestablished or continued by the General Assembly, this part shall stand repealed
13 in its entirety on July 1, ~~2004~~ 2009."

14 **SECTION 2.**

15 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
16 without such approval.

17 **SECTION 3.**

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
