

WITHDRAWN

1 Senator Zamarripa of the 36th offered the following amendment:

2 Amend the substitute HB 191 by adding after the word and symbol "motorcycles;" on line
3 9 of page 1 the following:

4 "to provide for a driver's license for certain persons who are not citizens of the United States;
5 to amend Article 1 of Chapter 11 of Title 19 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
6 relating to the Child Support Recovery Act, so as to change certain provisions relating to the
7 duty to furnish information about the obligor to the department;"

8 By renumbering Section 4 as Section 5, Section 5 as Section 6, Section 6 as Section 7,
9 Section 7 as Section 9, Section 8 as Section 10, and Section 9 as Section 11.

10 By inserting a new Section 4 to read as follows:

11 **"SECTION 4.**

12 Chapter 5 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to drivers' licenses,
13 is amended by adding a new Code Section 40-5-28.2 to read as follows:

14 '40-5-28.2.

15 (a) As used in this Code section, the term "Free Trade Area of the Americas" means
16 Argentina, the Bahamas, Barbados, Barbuda, Belize, Bolivia, Brazil, Canada, Chile,
17 Colombia, Costa Rica, Dominica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Granada,
18 Guatemala, Guyana, Haiti, Honduras, Jamaica, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Paraguay,
19 Peru, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Suriname,
20 Trinidad and Tobago, Uruguay, and Venezuela.

21 (b) Any person who is a citizen of any nation included in the Free Trade Area of the
22 Americas or who is a citizen of another country who provides to the department a driver's
23 license issued from his or her country of origin or general residency to the extent that such
24 drivers' licenses are acceptable under subsection (c) of Code Section 40-5-25, a federal tax
25 identification number, a valid passport, or a certified citizenship or birth documents issued
26 by a consulate or embassy in the United States, and who satisfies all applicable eligibility
27 requirements for a noncommercial class of driver's license other than United States
28 citizenship or proof of legal authorization from the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization
29 Service may be issued a driver's license for such class under this Code section.

30 (c) The information provided to the department under subsection (b) of this Code section
31 shall be retained by the department. The information shall be available only to department

1 personnel to be used for purposes of Aid to Families with Dependent Children, Temporary
 2 Assistance to Needy Families, child support enforcement, and federal and state tax
 3 purposes. Information collected pursuant to this subsection shall not be available to any
 4 public or private entity, except as authorized by federal or state law.

5 (d) Any person who knowingly makes any false statement or submits any false document,
 6 including any false identification relating to information as provided in subsection (b) of
 7 this Code section in an application for a driver's license provided for by this Code section
 8 shall be guilty of a violation of Code Section 16-10-20.

9 (e) Nothing in this Code section shall conflict with or supplant laws or policies of the
 10 United States government, the Department of Immigration and Naturalization Services, the
 11 Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996, the Department of
 12 Homeland Security, the Department of State, or the Internal Revenue Service."

13 By adding a new Section 8 to read as follows:

14 **"SECTION 8.**

15 Article 1 of Chapter 11 of Title 19 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
 16 Child Support Recovery Act, is amended by striking paragraph (1) of subsection (a.1) of
 17 Code Section 19-11-9.1, relating to the duty to furnish information about the obligor to the
 18 department, and inserting in its place the following:

19 '(a.1)(1) In accordance with the mandate contained in 42 U.S.C. Section 666(a)(13)(A)
 20 ~~and notwithstanding any provision of Title 40 relating to motor vehicles as now existing~~
 21 ~~or hereafter amended~~, the Department of Motor Vehicle Safety shall require an applicant
 22 for a driver's license, a commercial driver's license, a learner's permit, or an
 23 identification card to provide to the Department of Motor Vehicle Safety the applicant's
 24 social security number as part of the application. Applicants who do not have a social
 25 security number may provide to the Department of Motor Vehicle Safety any one of the
 26 following documents: a driver's license issued from his or her country of origin or
 27 general residency to the extent that such drivers' licenses are acceptable under subsection
 28 (c) of Code Section 40-5-25, a federal tax identification number, a valid passport, or a
 29 certified citizenship document or birth document issued by a consulate or embassy in the
 30 United States. The Department of Motor Vehicle Safety shall provide to the Department
 31 of Human Resources, in addition to other information required to be provided to the
 32 Department of Human Resources, such social security numbers or other forms of
 33 identification authorized by this subsection of individuals who have been issued a driver's
 34 license, a commercial driver's license, a learner's permit, or an identification card. The
 35 Department of Human Resources shall use the information provided by the Department

1 of Motor Vehicle Safety pursuant to this Code section for the purpose of complying with
2 the requirements of law concerning the enforcement of child support.”
