

House Bill 830 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act providing for election of members of the board of education of Tattnall  
2 County, approved February 29, 1968 (Ga. L. 1968, p. 2077), as amended, particularly by an  
3 Act approved April 11, 2002 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 3922), so as to change certain district  
4 descriptions for purposes of electing members of the board; to provide for submission; to  
5 provide effective dates; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act providing for election of members of the board of education of Tattnall County,  
9 approved February 29, 1968 (Ga. L. 1968, p. 2077), as amended, particularly by an Act  
10 approved April 11, 2002 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 3922), is amended in subsection (a) of Section 2  
11 by striking the descriptions of Districts 1 and 2 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:  
12 "Districts 1 and 2 shall be and correspond to those two numbered districts described in and  
13 attached to and made a part of this Act and further identified as Plan Name: tat02amd Plan  
14 Type: Local User: Linda Administrator: Tattnall Co."

15 **SECTION 2.**

16 The Board of Education of Tattnall County shall through its legal counsel cause this Act to  
17 be submitted for preclearance under the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; and  
18 such submission shall be made to the United States Department of Justice or filed with the  
19 appropriate court no later than 45 days after the date on which this Act is approved by the  
20 Governor or otherwise becomes law without such approval.

21 **SECTION 3.**

22 This section and Section 2 of this Act and those provisions of this Act necessary for the  
23 election of members of the Board of Education of Tattnall County in 2004 shall become

1 effective upon the approval of this Act by the Governor or upon its becoming law without  
2 such approval. The remaining provisions of this Act shall become effective January 1, 2005.

3 **SECTION 4.**

4 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
