A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Barbara Kitchens and congratulating her on her retirement; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Barbara Kitchens served as the Executive Director of the Sciences and
4 Professions Section of the Georgia Secretary of State Professional Licensing Boards Division
5 from 1981 to 2003; and

6 WHEREAS, as Executive Director, her responsibilities included serving as administrative
7 support for seven state licensing boards that regulate eight professions, including certified
8 and registered public accountants and their firms, architects, foresters, geologists, interior
9 designers, landscape architects, librarians, and water and wastewater treatment plant
10 operators and laboratory analysts; and

11 WHEREAS, in recognition of her outstanding accomplishments, Barbara Kitchens was
12 awarded the President's Medal by the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards,
13 and the Woman of Achievement Award by the Athens Business and Professional Women's
14 Club; and

15 WHEREAS, Barbara Kitchens has served well the citizens of the State of Georgia.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 commend Barbara Kitchens for over 20 years of efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated
18 public service to the citizens of her state; convey to her their heartiest congratulations upon
19 the occasion of her retirement; and extend to her their most sincere best wishes for continued
