## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing regret at the passing of L. Clifford Adams, Jr.; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia recently lost one of its finest and most distinguished  
3 citizens with the tragic passing of L. Clifford Adams, Jr.; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was an honest and dedicated lawyer who strived for excellence in all his  
5 endeavors as evidenced dramatically by decades of service in the areas of municipal, utilities,  
6 corporation, and real estate law; and
- 7 WHEREAS, this beloved individual who conceived and helped initiate the Municipal  
8 Electric Authority of Georgia and the Municipal Gas Authority of Georgia and who served  
9 as the first general counsel of the Georgia Municipal Association exhibited extraordinary  
10 devotion to duty, outstanding loyalty, fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in  
11 all his duties throughout his life; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
13 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and
- 14 WHEREAS, his unparalleled organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience  
15 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his acute sensitivity to the needs of the citizens  
16 of his community and state earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and  
17 associates; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the tragic passing of this generous, kind, and devoted family man leaves an  
19 unfillable void in the hearts and lives of his family and friends.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
21 express their deepest and most sincere regret at the passing of L. Clifford Adams, Jr.
