## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 16-5-60 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 reckless conduct causing harm to or endangering the bodily safety of another, so as to
- 3 prohibit assault with body fluids, saliva, or feces by a person who is infected with HIV or
- 4 hepatitis against a peace officer or correctional officer; to prescribe penalties for violations;
- 5 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 16-5-60 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to reckless conduct
- 9 causing harm to or endangering the bodily safety of another, is amended by adding at its end
- 10 a new subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 11 "(d) A person who is an HIV infected person or hepatitis infected person and who, after
- obtaining knowledge of being infected with HIV or hepatitis, commits an assault with the
- intent to transmit HIV or hepatitis, using his or her body fluids (blood, semen, or vaginal
- secretions), saliva, urine, or feces upon:
- 15 (1) A peace officer while the peace officer is engaged in the performance of his or her
- official duties or on account of the peace officer's performance of his or her official
- 17 duties; or
- 18 (2) A correctional officer while the correctional officer is engaged in the performance
- of his or her official duties or on account of the correctional officer's performance of his
- or her official duties
- 21 is guilty of a felony and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by imprisonment for
- 22 not less than five nor more than 20 years."

23 SECTION 2.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
