

1 The Senate Transportation Committee offered the following amendment:

2 Amend HR 132 by striking line 1 through 21 on page 1 and inserting in lieu thereof the
3 following:

4 "Designating certain transportation facilities in honor of those who have served their country
5 in the Armed Forces and certain transportation facilities in honor of or in memory of certain
6 distinguished citizens and making certain other designations; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 The following transportation facilities are designated as follows:

- 10 (1) That portion of State Route 232 in Columbia County from its intersection with State
11 Route 104 to its intersection with State Route 47 is designated as the 'Purple Heart
12 Highway';
- 13 (2) That portion of Highway 441 from the Jackson County line to the Habersham County
14 line is designated as the 'Veterans Memorial Highway';
- 15 (3) The interchange of Interstate 285 and Chamblee Dunwoody Road is designated as the
16 'J. Max Davis Interchange';
- 17 (4) The interchange of Interstate 85 and State Route 316 is designated as the 'Keith
18 Kalland Interchange';
- 19 (5) That portion of State Route 101 in Paulding County from Harmony Road at Concord
20 Baptist Church south to the Carroll County line is designated as the 'John D. Smith
21 Highway';
- 22 (6) State Route 121 is designated as the 'Woodpecker Trail'; and
- 23 (7) State Route 6 Business in Austell is designated as the 'Dr. Luke Garrett Bypass.'

24 **SECTION 2.**

25 The Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to place and maintain
26 appropriate markers designating said transportation facilities as provided for in Section 1 of
27 this resolution.

SECTION 3.

2 Either House of the General Assembly or both may by adoption of one or more privileged
3 resolutions recite an official designation provided for in this resolution together with
4 appropriate recitals supporting such designation; and any such resolution may be used for
5 appropriate ceremonial purposes in connection with such designation.

7 All prior resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed."
