A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Mrs. Martha Talbot Eaves for her many, many years of faithful service
2 advocating for Georgia's elder citizens; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Martha Talbot Eaves has provided valuable leadership to the Georgia
4 Council on Aging, serving as Vice-Chair from 1990 to 1994, as Chair from 1996-2002, and
5 as Immediate Past Chair since 2002; and

6 WHEREAS, she was an energetic member of the Long Term Care Advisory Committee of
7 the Georgia Department of Medical Assistance; and

8 WHEREAS, she was appointed by Governor Miller to the Georgia Long Term Study
9 Commission and to the Elder Abuse Task Force by Lt. Governor Howard; and

10 WHEREAS, she participates actively as a member of the Aging Services Task Force of the
11 Atlanta Regional Commission; and

12 WHEREAS, her indefatigable efforts have been recognized by outstanding awards, including
13 the Tom Murphy Award in 2002; the Georgia Gerontology Society John Tyler Mauldin
14 Award; the State Bar of Georgia, Young Lawyers Section, Elder Rights Award; and the
15 Older Women's League Role Model of the Year.

17 commend the indomitable spirit of Martha Talbot Eaves and her eloquent advocacy on behalf
18 of Georgia's elder citizens.
