

1 Senator Thomas of the 2nd offered the following amendment:

2 Amend HB 726 by striking line 3 on page 1 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

3 "definition of the term 'land surveying'; to amend Code Section 43-15-29 of the Official  
4 Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exceptions to operation of chapter, so as to provide  
5 for an additional exception; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting".

6 By redesignating Section 2 as Section 3 and inserting after line 8 on page 2 the following:

7 **"SECTION 2.**

8 Code Section 43-15-29 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exceptions to  
9 operation of chapter, is amended by adding a new subsection (f) to read as follows:

10 '(f) Nothing in this chapter shall limit registered land surveyors from performing work  
11 provided for in this chapter or in Chapter 7 of Title 12, the "Erosion and Sedimentation  
12 Act of 1972," on any commercial, industrial, or residential site within any county,  
13 municipality, or consolidated government in this state."
