- 2 WHEREAS, Andrew Dolder, a member of Boy Scout Troop 71 in Fayetteville, Georgia, will
3 receive the Eagle Scout Award at an Eagle Scout Court of Honor Ceremony; and
- 4 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle Scout Award has been the symbol of the highest and most
5 prestigious achievement among the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 6 WHEREAS, only two of every 100 boys who join Cub Scouts achieve the rank of Eagle
7 Scout; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the attainment of this rank indicates that Andrew has developed leadership
9 ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities that will be
10 of immense benefit throughout his life; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Andrew joined Troop 71 in 1999 and has served as a Patrol Leader and an
12 Assistant Patrol Leader; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Andrew has earned 29 merit badges, 12 of which are mandatory requirements
14 for the Eagle Scout program; he is a member of the Order of the Arrow; he has successfully
15 completed an approved Eagle Project; he has performed 29 hours of community service
16 hours during the past two years; and he has successfully completed an Eagle Scout Board of
17 Review; and
- 18 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Andrew Dolder has brought honor to himself,
19 his parents, and his troop.
