A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Effingham County 2002-2003 STAR students and STAR teachers; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Effingham County high schools have selected two students as the Effingham
4 County 2002-2003 STAR (Student Teacher Achievement Recognition) students and each
5 student, in turn, has named her STAR teacher in recognition of the impact that each has had
6 on the student's academic success; and

7 WHEREAS, the schools, and the student and teacher from each, recognized for their
8 outstanding accomplishments include: Effingham County High, Teresa Lynch and teacher
9 Maureen O'Bryan; and South Effingham High, Jessica Price and teacher Terri Powers; and

10 WHEREAS, to be selected as the STAR student for a high school a student must have
11 obtained the highest score on the Scholastic Assessment Test in his or her senior year and be
12 in the top 10 percent or top ten students of his or her class; and

13 WHEREAS, in addition, Jessica Price of South Effingham High was designated as the
14 county's STAR student winner and will represent her school and district in the district
15 competition; and Terri Powers was designated as the county's STAR teacher; and

16 WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to recognize appropriately the accomplishments and
17 achievements of these remarkable students and their teachers.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
19 the members of this body commend the Effingham County STAR students and their STAR
20 teachers and express to them their sincerest best wishes for continued success in the future.
