

House Bill 505 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To repeal an Act providing for a four-month vehicle registration period for Webster County,
2 approved March 25, 1996 (Ga. L. 1996, p. 3662), as amended, particularly by an Act
3 approved April 21, 1997 (Ga. L. 1997, p. 4266); to specify the vehicle registration period for
4 Webster County; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act providing for a four-month vehicle registration period for Webster County, approved
8 March 25, 1996 (Ga. L. 1996, p. 3662), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April
9 21, 1997 (Ga. L. 1997, p. 4266), is repealed effective January 1 of the second calendar year
10 following the year in which this Act is approved by the Governor or becomes law without
11 such approval. Accordingly, on and after the date of such repeal, the registration period for
12 vehicles in Webster County, including without limitation those vehicles for which
13 registration and licensing is issued in the calendar year immediately preceding such repeal
14 for expiration in the calendar year of such repeal, shall be as provided by subparagraph
15 (a)(1)(A) of Code Section 40-2-21 of the O.C.G.A. or as otherwise provided by general law
16 for those counties for which local Acts providing for four-month registration periods have
17 not been enacted.

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
