

**ADOPTED**

1 Senator Hooks of the 14th offered the following amendment:

2 Amend HB 380 by striking all matter on lines 19 through 28 of page 2 and inserting in lieu  
3 thereof the following:

4 "as the state seal: consist of a square canton on a field of three horizontal bands of equal  
5 width. The top and bottom bands shall be scarlet and the center band white. The bottom  
6 band shall extend the entire length of the flag, while the center and top bands shall extend  
7 from the canton to the fly end of the flag. The canton of the flag shall consist of a square  
8 of blue the width of two of the bands, in the upper left of the hoist of the flag. In the center  
9 of the canton shall be placed a representation in gold of the coat of arms of Georgia as  
10 shown in the center of the obverse of the Great Seal of the State of Georgia adopted in  
11 1799 and amended in 1914. Centered immediately beneath the coat of arms shall be the  
12 words "IN GOD WE TRUST" in capital letters. The coat of arms and wording "IN GOD  
13 WE TRUST" shall be encircled by 13 white five-pointed stars, representing Georgia and  
14 the 12 other original states that formed the United States of America. Official specifications  
15 of the flag, including color identification system, type sizes and fonts, and overall  
16 dimensions, shall be established by the Secretary of State, who pursuant to Code Section  
17 50-3-4 serves as custodian of the state flag. Every force of the organized militia shall carry  
18 this flag while on parade or review."

19 By striking all matter beginning with line 25 of page 3 and ending with line 2 of page 4 and  
20 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

21 “(a) The flag of the State of Georgia shall consist of a square canton on a field of three  
22 horizontal bands of equal width. The top and bottom bands shall be scarlet and the center  
23 band white. The bottom band shall extend the entire length of the flag, while the center and  
24 top bands shall extend from the canton to the fly end of the flag. The canton of the flag  
25 shall consist of a square of blue the width of two of the bands, in the upper left of the hoist  
26 of the flag. In the center of the canton shall be placed a representation in gold of the coat  
27 of arms of Georgia as shown in the center of the obverse of the Great Seal of the State of  
28 Georgia adopted in 1799 and amended in 1914. Centered immediately beneath the coat of  
29 arms shall be the words "IN GOD WE TRUST" in capital letters. The coat of arms and  
30 wording "IN GOD WE TRUST" shall be encircled by 13 white five-pointed stars,  
31 representing Georgia and the 12 other original states that formed the United States of  
32 America. Official specifications of the flag, including color identification system, type  
33 sizes and fonts, and overall dimensions, shall be established by the Secretary of State, who

4 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 band white. The bottom band shall extend the entire length of the flag, while the center and  
8 top bands shall extend from the canton to the fly end of the flag. The canton of the flag

10 of the flag. In the center of the canton shall be placed a representation in gold of the coat
