

House Bill 660 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act providing a board of education of Troup County, approved January 1, 1986  
2 (Ga. L. 1986, p. 3515), as amended, particularly by an Act approved March 18, 2002 (Ga.  
3 L. 2002, p. 3600), so as to correct a technical error and omissions in said 2002 amendatory  
4 Act; to provide that all members of the board who are elected thereto shall be nominated and  
5 elected in accordance with the Georgia Election Code in nonpartisan primaries and elections;  
6 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 An Act providing a board of education of Troup County, approved January 1, 1986 (Ga. L.  
10 1986, p. 3515), as amended, particularly by an Act approved March 18, 2002 (Ga. L. 2002,  
11 p. 3600), is amended by striking subsection (c) of Section 4 and inserting in its place a new  
12 subsection (c) to read as follows:

13 "(c) All members of the board who are elected thereto shall be nominated and elected in  
14 accordance with Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the 'Georgia Election Code,' in  
15 nonpartisan primaries and elections as provided in Code Section 21-2-139 of the O.C.G.A."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 The purpose of this Act is to replace language that was unintentionally and erroneously  
18 omitted from the amendatory Act, providing a board of education of Troup County, approved  
19 March 18, 2002 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 3600). It was the intention of the 2002 Act to revise district  
20 lines only and not the method of election.

21 **SECTION 3.**

22 This Act is intended, to the maximum extent possible, to ratify and confirm any election  
23 previously held in conformity with the provisions of this Act.

2 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
