

**ADOPTED**

1 Senators Kemp of the 3rd and Johnson of the 1st offered the following amendment:

2 Amend HB 327 by inserting on line 4 of page 1 following the word and symbol "meter;" the  
3 following:

4 "to provide for period for certain businesses to continue business operations after the death  
5 of the licensee;".

6 By redesignating Sections 2 through 4 as Sections 3 through 5, respectively.

7 By inserting between lines 3 and 4 of page 2 the following:

8 **"SECTION 2.**

9 Said chapter is further amended by striking subsection (h) of Code Section 43-14-8, relating  
10 to licensing required for electrical, plumbing, or conditioned air contracting, and inserting  
11 in lieu thereof a new subsection (h) to read as follows:

12 '(h) No partnership, limited liability company, or corporation shall have the right to engage  
13 in the business of conditioned air contracting unless there is regularly connected with such  
14 partnership, limited liability company, or corporation a person or persons actually engaged  
15 in the performance of such business on a full-time basis who have valid licenses issued to  
16 them as provided for in this chapter; provided, however, that partners, officers, and  
17 employees of the individual who fulfilled the licensing requirements shall continue to be  
18 authorized to engage in the business of conditioned air contracting under a license which  
19 was valid at the time of the licensee's death for a period of 90 days following the date of  
20 such death."
