- 9 Street, which was completed in 1928 and to which major additions have since been made,
- 10 including a spacious new parish hall completed in 2001; and
- 11 WHEREAS, under the leadership of current senior minister Rev. Gary Parrish, membership
- 12 now stands at 1,777 souls, and the church remains dedicated to its mission of glorifying God
- 13 through proclamation of the Gospel and service to God's creation; and
- WHEREAS, the church will hold its 175th anniversary celebration on Heritage Sunday, April27, 2003.

  the members of this body congratulate and commend Newnan First United Methodist Church
  upon the occasion of the church's 175th anniversary and extend every good wish for the
