- 8 WHEREAS, during 50 years of dedicated service with the Kingsland Lions Club, including
9 several terms serving as President or Secretary, he has never missed a meeting; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he is a former owner and publisher of "The Southeast Georgian", a local
11 newspaper, and has recently written and compiled a book entitled, "A Brief History of the
12 Lions Club of Kingsland, Ga."; and
- 13 WHEREAS, from 1942 to 1945, he served as a member of the U. S. Army Ordnance
14 Department in North Africa and Italy; and
- 15 WHEREAS, for the past 55 years, he has been a member of the American Legion; and
- 16 WHEREAS, since 1926, he has been a faithful member of the Kingsland United Methodist
17 Church where he has held almost every office at least twice and has been a member of the
18 choir for 53 years.
