## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Alex Gallman on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Alex Gallman has earned the rank of Eagle Scout, to be awarded during a  
3 ceremony on April 27, 2003; and

4 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle has been the symbol of the highest achievement among  
5 the Boy Scouts of America; and

7 leadership ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities  
8 that will be of immense benefit throughout life; and

11 WHEREAS, for a Scout to reach Eagle rank, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of which are
