## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Paying tribute to Honorable Walter Bain Proctor, Jr.; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Walter Bain Proctor, Jr., will be long remembered by the citizens of Griffin,  
3 Georgia, for his exceptional leadership as an involved civic, business, and religious leader  
4 who significantly improved the quality of life for his fellow citizens; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he was born on October 11, 1943, in Thomaston, Upson County, Georgia, the  
6 only child of Pauline and Walter Proctor; and he attended Thomaston City Schools and  
7 graduated from Baylor Preparatory School in Chattanooga, Tennessee; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he served in the U.S. Navy 1963-1967; married Carole Wilder on March 18,  
9 1967; graduated from Georgia State University in 1970; and fathered three fine children:  
10 Walter Bain Proctor III, Daniel Wesley Proctor, and Heather Lynn Proctor; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he came to Griffin as a manager with State Farm Insurance in June, 1979, and  
12 he quickly became involved in civic affairs, was elected mayor of Griffin, became a member  
13 of the Board of Commissioners of Spalding County, and served as the chairman; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he was chairman of the Spalding County Republican Party, was a member of  
15 the Salvation Army executive committee and served twice as its chairman, and was  
16 instrumental in purchasing the land and creating Volunteer Park as the site for various  
17 community youth recreation programs; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the wonderful initiatives and extraordinary leadership of this outstanding civic  
19 leader in Griffin, Georgia, are an inspiration to others and will be honored forever.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
21 this body pays tribute to the Honorable Walter Bain Proctor, Jr., for his superb public service  
22 and conveys its sincerest sympathy to his beloved family.
