- 13 WHEREAS, in 1938, she married James Spencer Bomar, Jr. and they had three children; and
- 14 WHEREAS, widowed in 1947, and again in 1972, she was happily united in marriage to
- 15 Leon Reed Hudson in 1996; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Mrs. Hudson served the Fulton County Board of Education for 33 years as an
- 17 elementary school teacher and as a principal; and
- 18 WHEREAS, upon retirement from the educational system, she served six terms as a member
- 19 of the Georgia House of Representatives; and

- 1 WHEREAS, in 1988, she was named Legislator of the Year by the Georgia Federation of
- 2 Women's Clubs and the Georgia Nursing Home Association; and
- 3 WHEREAS, in that same year, she was also crowned Georgia Mother of the Year; and
- 4 WHEREAS, she was a member of Fairburn United Methodist Church; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Mrs. Hudson contributed enormously to the well-being of her family, 6 community, and state, and for her gracious service and significant deeds we are most 7 grateful.
