## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring Mrs. Narvie Jordan Harris; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Narvie Jordan Harris was born in Wrightsville, Johnson County, Georgia, and  
3 became one of the state's most remarkable and effective educators; and

4 WHEREAS, she attended Atlanta public schools and received further education at Clark  
5 College, Atlanta University, the Tuskegee Institute, Tennessee State University, Grambling  
6 State University, Wayne State University, the University of Georgia, and Georgia State  
7 University; and

8 WHEREAS, she was a classroom teacher of extraordinary ability who influenced the lives  
9 of students at all educational levels including elementary, secondary, postsecondary, and  
10 adult education; and

11 WHEREAS, from 1944 until her retirement in 1983, she served as instructional supervisor  
12 for the DeKalb County Board of Education; and

13 WHEREAS, she served as a member of dozens of religious, educational, and civic  
14 organizations where she has generously contributed her knowledge and ability in service to  
15 others; and

16 WHEREAS, Mrs. Harris has given of herself in so many capacities and with such consistent  
17 dedication to the common good that her life has become a pattern worthy of both  
18 commendation and emulation.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
20 honor Mrs. Narvie Jordan Harris and express to her their immense appreciation for her many  
21 years of extraordinary service to the citizens of the State of Georgia and for her enduring  
22 contributions to the field of education.
