

ADOPTED

1 Senators Lee of the 29th, Hudgens of the 47th, Tolleson of the 18th and Starr of the 44th
2 offered the following amendment:

3 Amend HB 319 by adding after "license;" on line 7 of page 1 the following:

4 "to change certain provisions relating to expiration and renewal of drivers' licenses and
5 reexamination requirements;".

6 By adding after "matters;" on line 8 of page 1 the following:

7 "to provide effective dates;".

8 By redesignating Section 3 as Section 5.

9 By adding new Sections 3 and 4 to read as follows:

10 **"SECTION 3.**

11 Said article is further amended by striking paragraph (1) of subsection (a) of Code Section
12 40-5-32, relating to expiration and renewal of drivers' licenses and reexamination
13 requirements, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

14 '(a)(1) Every driver's license shall expire on the licensee's birthday in the fourth year
15 following the issuance of such license, provided, however, that, if the licensee is an alien
16 with legal authorization from the United States Immigration and Naturalization Service
17 whose legal authorization, as evidenced by written documentation from the United States
18 Immigration and Naturalization Service, expires prior to the licensee's birthday in the
19 fourth year following issuance, the driver's license shall expire on the date on which such
20 authorization expires. If such date is six months or less from the date of application,
21 notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the driver's license shall
22 expire six months from the date of issuance. Every such license shall be renewed on or
23 before its expiration upon application, payment of the required fee, and, if applicable,
24 satisfactory completion of the examination required or authorized by subsection (c) of
25 this Code section.'

26 **SECTION 4.**

27 Sections 1, 2, and 4 of this Act shall become effective on July 1, 2003.

28 Section 3 of this Act shall become effective on January 1, 2004."
