A RESOLUTION

1 Commending C. David Saye; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, C. David Saye is a distinguished Georgian and an exemplary public
3 administrator who has served as the director of the Georgia Public Safety Training Center
4 since its formation under Governor George D. Busbee in 1981, and his leadership has
5 brought honor and credit to the center, its staff and graduates, and the State of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, he has a long history of accomplishment in the field of public safety, having
7 served as the director of the Northeast Georgia Police Academy in 1973 and as the chief of
8 the University of Georgia police department beginning in 1974; and

9 WHEREAS, he championed the creation of a public safety training center to provide officers
10 a solid training foundation, and his efforts and advocacy contributed substantially to the
11 completion of the state complex and graduation of the first class in 1987; and

12 WHEREAS, under his management, the very critical training component and administrative
13 coordination of the Georgia Police Academy and Georgia Fire Academy were added to the
14 center and he became the head of all three public safety agencies; and

15 WHEREAS, he was instrumental in creating the Georgia Public Safety Memorial which was
16 eventually completed in 1997 to pay tribute to the public safety officers who lost their lives
17 in the line of duty; and

18 WHEREAS, he received the Governor's Public Safety Award in 2002, and his
19 extraordinary service to his profession and to the citizens of Georgia merits high honor and
20 praise.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
2 this body commends C. David Saye for his exceptional service in the field of public safety
3 and conveys its best wishes for health and happiness in his retirement.
