## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the memory of Harvey E. Thompson and expressing regret at his passing; and for  
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, news of the passing of Harvey E. Thompson, late of Bowersville, is received  
4 with deep regret by this body; and

5 WHEREAS, the life led by this distinguished gentleman of 84 years rendered his name dear  
6 to the hearts of his family and fellow citizens alike; and

7 WHEREAS, he was a carpenter, charter member of the Lt. Dickson L. Baker Camp 926 of  
8 the Sons of Confederate Veterans, member of the Elberton Post of the Veterans of Foreign  
9 Wars, and member of Flat Shoals Baptist Church. He was a United States Army veteran of  
10 the Pacific Theater in World War II. He is survived by sons Harvey G. Thompson, Charlie  
11 T. Thompson, and Blake Thompson; brother, Buford Thompson; and numerous  
12 grandchildren and great-grandchildren; and

14 mingle our sympathies with the grief of his family and friends.
