A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing regret at the passing of Charles Michael "Mike" Coulter; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, on November 27, 2002, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest and most
3 distinguished citizens with the passing of Mike Coulter; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was an honest and dedicated man who strived for excellence in all his
5 endeavors as evidenced dramatically by his service with the U.S. Army, as a member of
6 Hartwell First Baptist Church, and as an area manager with Georgia Power; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he spent innumerable hours of his time serving his community on the board of
8 the Hart County Historical Society and Museum from 1989-1995; as a member of the
9 Hartwell Rotary Club, Hart County Community Leadership Advisory Committee,
10 Franklin-Hart-Stephens Joint Development Authority, Franklin/Hart Airport Authority, Hart
11 County Industrial Building Authority, and Hart County Industrial Development Authority;
12 as Georgia Power Company's Business Partner in Education with Hartwell Elementary
13 School since 1990; as a member of the Hart County Chamber of Commerce, where he was
14 elected president in 1991; as the Leukemia Society chairperson in 1991; as founder of the
15 Hart YMCA and American Cancer Society director in 1992; and as Hart County High School
16 Athletic Booster Club president from 1994-1995; and
- 17 WHEREAS, his leadership talents and sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of his
18 community and state earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates,
19 and he was named Business Person of the Year in Hartwell in 1998; and
- 20 WHEREAS, he was a beloved husband, father, brother, and grandfather, and he will always
21 be remembered for his kindness, dedication, generosity, and good nature by his family,
22 friends, and the members of his community.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
2 the members of this body express their deepest and most sincere regret at the passing of Mike
3 Coulter.
