## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Frank W. Sherrill; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Frank W. Sherrill has been the city engineer for the City of Blackshear since  
3 1989; and

4 WHEREAS, he holds a Bachelor of Civil Engineering from the Georgia Institute of  
5 Technology and a Master's of Business Administration from Georgia State University,  
6 served in the United States Army Corps of Engineers, worked for Southern Engineering  
7 Company of Georgia, and serves as president of Hightower Consulting Engineers; and

8 WHEREAS, he served as the mayor of the City of Social Circle from 1979-1997, as the  
9 president of the Georgia Municipal Association in 1988, on the Georgia Environmental  
10 Advisory Council, on the National League of Cities Environmental Steering Committee, on  
11 the Municipal Gas Authority of Georgia, on the Northeast Georgia Police Academy Advisory  
12 Board, and as a state host for the Georgia Chamber of Commerce's Georgia Red Carpet  
13 Tour; and

14 WHEREAS, as city engineer, he has gone above and beyond the duties of his job by  
15 designing improvements to the city's wastewater treatment system, including improvements  
16 to the wastewater treatment pond, the wastewater collection system, the mechanical plant,  
17 and the water distribution system, by expanding the land application system, and by helping  
18 to obtain funding in the form of GEFA loans and EIP, CDBG, and RAP grants through DCA  
19 totaling over \$3,500,000.00; and

20 WHEREAS, he is the loving husband of Joyce Sherrill, father of son Jeff, and father-in-law  
21 of Effi.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
23 the members of this body commend Frank W. Sherrill for his excellent service as the city

1 engineer for the City of Blackshear, and convey to him their most sincere wishes for
