

House Bill 856 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act providing a new charter for the City of Hampton, approved April 17, 1975  
2 (Ga. L. 1975, p. 4092), as amended, so as to repeal a provision prohibiting persons holding  
3 elective office from serving on boards, commissions, and authorities; to provide instead for  
4 a prohibition with respect to persons who are voting members of boards, commissions, and  
5 authorities; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act providing a new charter for the City of Hampton, approved April 17, 1975 (Ga. L.  
9 1975, p. 4092), as amended, is amended by striking subsection (b) of Section 3.11 which  
10 reads as follows:

11 "(b) No member of any board, commission, or authority shall hold any elective office in  
12 the City."

13 and inserting in place thereof the following:

14 "(b) No person who is a voting member of any board, commission, or authority shall hold  
15 any elective office in the City."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
