

House Bill 907 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating a new charter for the City of Pooler, approved March 31, 1976
2 (Ga. L. 1976, p. 3419), as amended, so as to change provisions relating to the powers and
3 duties of the mayor; to provide for a city manager; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
4 purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act creating a new charter for the City of Pooler, approved March 31, 1976 (Ga. L. 1976,
8 p. 3419), as amended, is amended by striking paragraph (2) of subsection (a) of Section 3.12
9 and inserting in place thereof the following:

10 "(2) with the advice and consent of city council, appoint and remove all officers,
11 department heads, and employees of the town;"

13 **SECTION 2.**

14 Said Act is further amended by adding a new Section 3.14 to read as follows:

15 "SECTION 3.14.

16 The mayor may, with the advice and consent of city council, or when authorized by
17 ordinance of the council, delegate or assign to a city manager such powers, functions, and
18 duties as are conferred upon the mayor by this charter and such delegation of powers may
19 be terminated, altered, or otherwise changed as the mayor and council shall deem
20 necessary, expedient, or helpful in the conduct of the affairs of the city."

21 **SECTION 3.**

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
