

## House Resolution 115 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

## A RESOLUTION

1 Designating that new portion of US 82 within the corporate limits of the City of Georgetown  
2 as Martin Luther King, Jr., Bypass; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the late Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., was a distinguished Georgian whose efforts  
4 to obtain a peaceful and just society earned a Nobel Prize; and

5 WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Georgetown resolved unanimously to  
6 request the General Assembly to honor the late Dr. King by designating the new portion of  
7 US 82 within the corporate limits of that city in his name; and

8 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that the life and memory of the late Dr. Martin  
9 Luther King be so honored as requested.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
11 GEORGIA that the new portion of US 82 within the corporate limits of the City of  
12 Georgetown is designated Martin Luther King, Jr., Bypass, and the Department of  
13 Transportation is authorized and directed to erect and maintain signs so identifying the  
14 highway.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
16 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the Department of  
17 Transportation and the Mayor and Council of the City of Georgetown.
