

Senate Resolution 563

A RESOLUTION

1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to provide that the people have the right
 2 to hunt, fish, and harvest game, subject only to reasonable restrictions as the General
 3 Assembly may prescribe by general law; to provide for submission of this amendment for
 4 ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

7 Article I, Section I of the Constitution is amended by renumbering Paragraph XXVIII as
 8 Paragraph XXIX and inserting a new Paragraph XXVIII to read as follows:

9 "Paragraph XXVIII. ***Right to hunt and fish.*** The people have the right to hunt, fish, and
 10 harvest game, subject only to reasonable restrictions as the General Assembly may
 11 prescribe by general law."

12 SECTION 2.

13 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
 14 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
 15 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:

16 "() YES Shall the Constitution be amended so as to provide that the people have the
 17 right to hunt, fish, and harvest game, subject only to reasonable restrictions

18 () NO as the General Assembly may prescribe by general law?"

19 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
 20 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
 21 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
 22 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
