#### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Matthew William Lynn on becoming an Eagle Scout; and for  
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Matthew William Lynn, a member of Venturing Crew #599 in Grayson,  
4 Georgia, will receive the Eagle Scout Award at an Eagle Scout Court of Honor Ceremony  
5 on January 10, 2004; and

6 WHEREAS, since 1911, the Eagle Scout Award has been the symbol of the highest  
7 achievement among the Boy Scouts of America; and

8 WHEREAS, the attainment of this rank indicates that a Scout has developed leadership  
9 ability, self-confidence, mature judgment, and mental and physical capabilities that will be  
10 of immense benefit throughout his life; and

11 WHEREAS, in order for a Scout to reach this goal, he must earn 21 merit badges, 12 of  
12 which are mandatory requirements for the Eagle Scout program; and

13 WHEREAS, Matthew William Lynn has demonstrated character and achievement in many  
14 ways, including service as a High Adventure Instructor for the Northeast Boy Scout Council,  
15 membership on the Parkview High School 2002 state championship football team, and other  
16 school and community activities; and

17 WHEREAS, in achieving Eagle Scout status, Matthew William Lynn has brought honor to  
18 himself, his troop, and his parents.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
20 recognize and commend Matthew William Lynn on attaining the rank of Eagle Scout and for  
21 the great credit he reflects on his community and the State of Georgia.
