A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Lettie "Boots" Ashworth and expressing gratitude for 45 years of service as
2 a public school teacher; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, in September, 2003, after working with Fayette County students for nearly a
4 half-century, Lettie "Boots" Ashworth retired from the Fayette County School System; and

5 WHEREAS, a native of Crawfordsville, Georgia, she came to Fayette County in 1958,
6 immediately after graduating with a degree in education from Tift College; and

7 WHEREAS, her first job was at Fayette County High School where she taught history,
8 government, and sociology; and

9 WHEREAS, she worked under seven superintendents, watched the county grow from a small
10 rural town to the Atlanta suburb it is today, and witnessed the building of four high schools,
11 five middle schools, and numerous elementary schools; and

12 WHEREAS, throughout all the changes, she maintained a thorough commitment to her
13 pivotal role as teacher and an abiding love for her students; and

14 WHEREAS, her contributions to the lives of those she taught and to our society were
15 significant and enduring.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 honor and commend Lettie "Boots" Ashworth for her outstanding public service as an
18 educator and express to her their immense gratitude for her 45 years of dedication to
19 Georgia's children.
