A RESOLUTION

1 Providing for a joint session of the Senate and the House of Representatives for the purpose
2 of an address by the President of the United States; and for other purposes.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that there is
4 authorized a joint session of the Senate and the House of Representatives, to be held in the
5 hall of the House of Representatives at such date and time as may be fixed by the President
6 Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the United States, the Honorable George
8 W. Bush, is hereby invited to address such joint session.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a committee of fourteen, seven from the Senate to be
10 named by the President Pro Tempore and seven from the House to be named by the Speaker,
11 shall be appointed to escort the President to the hall of the House of Representatives.
