A RESOLUTION

1 Remembering and honoring the life of Lucille Bolt Davenport; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its most remarkable citizens with the passing
3 of Lucille Bolt Davenport on May 23, 2003; and

4 WHEREAS, Mrs. Davenport was born on October 11, 1930, the beautiful daughter of Lucille
5 and John C. Bolt; and

6 WHEREAS, she was preceded in death by her husband and true love, George R. Davenport,
7 Sr., and a son, Mark Livingston Davenport; and

8 WHEREAS, Mrs. Davenport was truly an educated and scholarly woman, having graduated
9 from Graycourt High School and Furman University with a bachelor's degree in education,
10 and she would go on to attain a master's degree in special education from North Georgia
11 College; and

12 WHEREAS, Lucille Bolt Davenport was a generous and devoted teacher for 30 years and
13 was held in great regard by her students and fellow educators at Lanier Elementary School
14 and Centennial Elementary School; and

15 WHEREAS, a dedicated and selfless participant in her community, Mrs. Davenport was a
16 member, deacon, and an elder at her beloved First Presbyterian Church, and was just as
17 involved with the Georgia and Hall County Democratic Party, the Auxiliary of the Northeast
18 Georgia Medical Center, and the Elachee Nature Science Center; and

19 WHEREAS, Mrs. Davenport leaves behind her devoted family of two sons, Bob and David
20 Davenport, daughter Marjorie D. McCrory, sister Eleanor Hunt, and six blessed
21 grandchildren.
