8 Darnell's round of 81, fellow senior Lindsey Thompson's season best 85, and Beth Parks's
9 solid finishing round sealed the Red Elephants first girls state golf title; and

10 WHEREAS, the outstanding accomplishments of this great team generated well-deserved
11 attention and strengthened school spirit at Gainesville High, and leaving memories the team
12 members and their fellow students will cherish forever; and

14 athletic ability, the dedication and hard work, and the unity of purpose and spirit of each
15 member of the team; their superb talents; and the astute direction of Coach Manson Hill.
