The House Committee on Retirement offers the following substitute to HB 878:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 47-2-262 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 membership of assistant district attorneys and employees of the Prosecuting Attorneys'
- 3 Council of the State of Georgia in the Employees' Retirement System of Georgia, notice of
- 4 election, and contributions, so as to provide for creditable service for certain members who
- 5 were required to become members of the Employees' Retirement System of Georgia as a
- 6 matter of law but who failed to do so because of an administrative error; to provide that such
- 7 persons may obtain the prior service credit to which each is entitled by paying to the board
- 8 of trustees employer and employee contributions with interest thereon; to provide that such
- 9 payments shall be credited to each member's annuity account; to provide conditions for an
- 10 effective date and automatic repeal; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

12 SECTION 1.

- 13 Code Section 47-2-262 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to membership
- 14 of assistant district attorneys and employees of the Prosecuting Attorneys' Council of the
- 15 State of Georgia in the Employees' Retirement System of Georgia, notice of election, and
- 16 contributions, is amended by inserting at the end thereof the following:
- 17 "(c) Any person who was required to become a member of this retirement system by
- operation of subsection (b) of this Code section but who failed to do so at the time he or
- she was so required because of an administrative error may receive creditable service for
- all or a portion of such period of prior service by paying to the board of trustees an amount
- 21 which would warrant the grant of creditable service without creating any additional
- actuarial accrued liability as to the retirement system. Such payment may include a transfer
- of funds from a money purchase pension plan maintained by the employee's employer
- prior to July 1, 2004, which shall be credited to the employee's annuity account established
- by the retirement system. The employee's employer is authorized to supplement such
- 26 amount."

SECTION 2.

2 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2004, only if it is determined to have been

- 3 concurrently funded as provided in Chapter 20 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 4 Annotated, the "Public Retirement Systems Standards Law"; otherwise, this Act shall not
- 5 become effective and shall be automatically repealed in its entirety on July 1, 2004, as
- 6 required by subsection (a) of Code Section 47-20-50.

7 SECTION 3.

8 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
