A RESOLUTION

- 1 Requesting the Department of Transportation to study the feasibility of implementing
- 2 high-occupancy toll ("HOT") lanes; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, traffic congestion along the highways is a significant and growing problem in
- 4 the metropolitan Atlanta area; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the general purpose lanes of highways are often clogged during rush hours,
- 6 while the existing HOV lanes are frequently underused; and
- 7 WHEREAS, opening existing HOV lanes to paying customers as HOT lanes is a potential
- 8 means to reduce traffic congestion and to benefit all highway users; and
- 9 WHEREAS, in particular, traffic congestion along the GA 400 Corridor could be reduced
- 10 significantly by the addition of HOV and HOT lanes.
- 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the Department of
- 12 Transportation is requested to undertake a comprehensive study of the feasibility of
- 13 implementing HOT lanes along the highways of the metropolitan Atlanta area and
- 14 implementing HOV and HOT lanes along the GA 400 Corridor. The Department of
- 15 Transportation is requested to make a report of its findings and recommendations to the
- 16 Senate Transportation Committee on or before December 1, 2004.
- 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 18 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Commissioner of the Department of
- 19 Transportation.
