A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

| 1 | To amend Article 1 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, |
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| 2 | relating to general provisions regarding uniform rules of the road, so as to prohibit the use |
| 3 | of traffic-control device preemption emitters or similar devices by any person other than law |
| 4 | enforcement, fire department, or emergency personnel; to provide for criminal penalties; to |
| 5 | provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes. |
| 6 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA: |
| 7 | SECTION 1. |
| 8 | Article 1 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to |
| 9 | general provisions regarding uniform rules of the road, is amended by adding a new Code |
| 10 | section at the end thereof, to be designated Code Section 40-6-17, to read as follows: |
| 11 | ″40-6-17. |
| 12 | (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'traffic-control device preemption emitter' means |
| 13 | a mobile infrared transmitter or any other similar device which transmits an infrared beam, |
| 14 | radio wave, or other signal used for the purpose of changing, altering, disabling, or |
| 15 | disrupting the normal signal sequence of a traffic-control device. |
| 16 | (b) It shall be unlawful for any person other than law enforcement, fire department, or |
| 17 | emergency personnel to use a traffic-control device preemption emitter. |
| 18 | (c) Any person who violates subsection (b) of this Code section shall be guilty of a |
| 19 | misdemeanor." |
| 20 | SECTION 2. |
| 21 | This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law |
| 22 | without such approval. |
| 23 | SECTION 3. |
| 24 | All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed. |
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
