

House Bill 1117

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 50-27-34 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
2 legislative oversight committee for the Georgia Lottery Corporation, so as to change the
3 reference to the House Committee on Industry to the House Committee on Regulated
4 Industries to conform such reference to the committee name as adopted by resolution by the
5 Georgia House of Representatives; to provide for editorial revision; to provide an effective
6 date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Code Section 50-27-34 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the legislative
10 oversight committee for the Georgia Lottery Corporation, is amended by striking subsection
11 (a) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

12 "(a) There is created as a joint committee of the General Assembly, the Georgia Lottery
13 Corporation Legislative Oversight Committee, to be composed of the members of the
14 House Committee on ~~Industry~~ Regulated Industries and the Senate Committee on
15 Economic Development, and Tourism, ~~and Cultural Affairs~~. The ~~chairmen~~ chairpersons
16 of such committees shall serve as ~~cochairmen~~ cochairpersons of the oversight committee.
17 The oversight committee shall periodically inquire into and review the operations of the
18 Georgia Lottery Corporation, as well as periodically review and evaluate the success with
19 which the authority is accomplishing its statutory duties and functions as provided in this
20 chapter. The oversight committee may conduct any independent audit or investigation of
21 the authority it deems necessary."

22 **SECTION 2.**

23 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
24 without such approval.
