1 Senator Squires of the 5th offered the following amendment:

Amend SR 560 by striking ", in a manner consistent with the United States Constitution, so as to prevent discrimination in the public funding of social services by allowing religious or sectarian organizations to receive public aid, directly or indirectly, for the provision of such services;" on lines 1 through 4 of page 1 and inserting in lieu thereof "so as to repeal the prohibition against religious and sectarian denominations and institutions receiving public aid;".

- 8 By striking lines 10 through 13 on page 1 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 9 "Paragraph VII. Separation of church and state. No money shall ever be taken from the
 10 public treasury, directly or indirectly, in aid of any church, sect, cult, or religious
 11 denomination or of any sectarian institution <u>Reserved</u>.'"
- By striking lines 17 through 20 on page 1 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
 "above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:
- 14 '() YES Shall the Constitution be amended so as to repeal the prohibition against
- 15 () NO religious and sectarian denominations and institutions receiving public aid?'
- 16 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote 'Yes.'"
