A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to law enforcement  
2 officers and agencies, and Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
3 public officers and employees, so as to change a member on the Criminal Justice  
4 Coordinating Council from the chairperson of the Georgia Organized Crime Prevention  
5 Council to the director of homeland security; to discontinue the Organized Crime Prevention  
6 Council; to provide provisions for certain insurance for law enforcement personnel while on  
7 temporary assignment or loan to other law enforcement agencies for criminal investigative  
8 purposes; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

11 Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to law enforcement officers and  
12 agencies, is amended by striking paragraph (1) of subsection (a) of Code Section 35-6A-3,  
13 relating to membership and vacancies on the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council, and  
14 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

15 "(1) The chairperson of the Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council, the  
16 ~~chairperson of the Georgia Organized Crime Prevention Council~~ director of homeland  
17 security, the chairperson of the Judicial Council of Georgia, the chairperson of the  
18 Prosecuting Attorneys' Council of the State of Georgia, the commissioner of corrections,  
19 the chairperson of the Board of Corrections, the vice chairperson of the Board of Public  
20 Safety, the ~~chairman~~ chairperson of the State Board of Pardons and Paroles, the State  
21 School Superintendent, the commissioner of community affairs, the president of the  
22 Council of Juvenile Court Judges, the chairperson of the Georgia Public Defender  
23 Standards Council, the chairperson of the Children and Youth Coordinating Council, and  
24 the commissioner of juvenile justice or their designees shall be ex officio members of the  
25 council, as full voting members of the council by reason of their office; and".
