## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the George H.W. Bush Presidential Parkway; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, George Herbert Walker Bush has been a dedicated public servant, serving in
- 3 numerous significant roles in our country's federal government and attaining the pinnacle of
- 4 public service by being elected as the 41st President of the United States; and
- 5 WHEREAS, George H.W. Bush began his public service on his 18th birthday by enlisting
- 6 in the U.S. Navy, where he later became the youngest pilot in the Navy at the time and where
- 7 he was subsequently awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross and three Air Medals for his
- 8 courageous service in the Pacific Theater during World War II; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he was elected to the U.S. House of Representatives in 1966 to represent the 7th
- 10 District of Texas and served two terms through 1970; and
- 11 WHEREAS, from 1971 through 1973, he served as U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations,
- in 1973 as the chairman of the Republican National Committee, in 1974 as the chief of the
- 13 U.S. Liaison Office in the People's Republic of China, and from 1976 through 1980 as the
- 14 director of the Central Intelligence Agency; and
- 15 WHEREAS, in 1980, Mr. Bush was selected by Ronald Reagan to be his running mate in his
- 16 successful presidential campaign and subsequent reelection, and which resulted in his serving
- as Vice President of the United States from 1980 through 1988; and
- 18 WHEREAS, he received his party's nomination for President in 1988 and was elected,
- 19 serving as the 41st President of the United States from 1988 through 1992 and achieving
- 20 many improvements for this country during his tenure, both on the national and international
- 21 fronts; and

1 WHEREAS, he is a devoted family man, and he and his wife of 59 years, the former Barbara

- 2 Pierce, are the proud parents of five children, including the sitting President of the United
- 3 States and the Governor of Florida, and the grandparents of 14 grandchildren; and
- 4 WHEREAS, George Herbert Walker Bush has been a dedicated and esteemed citizen and
- 5 public servant and has provided countless contributions to this country and each state,
- 6 including the great State of Georgia.
- 7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 8 GEORGIA that the portion of State Route 20 in Henry County beginning at the west side of
- 9 Interstate 75 running west to the intersection of Richard Petty Boulevard be designated the
- 10 George H.W. Bush Presidential Parkway, and the Department of Transportation is directed
- 11 to place and maintain appropriate markers along such portion of State Route 20 as well as
- on or near the entrance and exit ramps on Interstate 75 at State Route 20.
- 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 14 to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the commissioner of transportation and
- 15 the Honorable George H.W. Bush.
