11 of the International Association of Assembly Managers, the American Society of Association
12 Executives, and the Georgia Hospitality and Travel Association; and

14 contributions he made of his time and energy by serving as chairman on the Government
15 Division of the United Way's Board of Directors, a trustee of the Lanier Technical Institute
16 Foundation, a deacon at Gainesville's First Baptist Church, and as a Little League coach; and

18 Catherine, Carol, Jamie, and Will, Bob Scanlin will forever be loved by his family and
