A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing regret at the passing of Spc. Nathaniel Henry Johnson; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, on January 8, 2004, the State of Georgia lost a distinguished citizen and a
3 dedicated soldier with the untimely death of Spc. Nathaniel Henry Johnson, the son of Mr.
4 Felix Johnson of Augusta, Georgia; and
- 5 WHEREAS, while serving with valor as a member of Company D (Aviation), 82nd Support
6 Battalion, 82nd Airborne Division, Spc. Johnson and eight other soldiers perished in the
7 crash of a UH-60 Blackhawk helicopter near Fallujah, Iraq; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he was born on March 15, 1981, in Camden, New Jersey, but had lived in
9 Augusta since he was nine years old; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he was a graduate of Glenn Hills High School, where he was a member of the
11 football team and the Naval Junior ROTC, and was an active member of the City of Refuge
12 Christ Learning Center in Hephzibah; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Spc. Johnson died while giving the gift of freedom to the people of Iraq and he
14 will be sorely missed by all who knew him; and
- 15 WHEREAS, we, the members of the House of Representatives, send our sympathy and
16 condolences to the family and friends of Spc. Nathaniel Henry Johnson.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 the members of this body express their deepest regret at the passing of Spc. Nathaniel Henry
19 Johnson and extend their sincerest sympathy to the members of his family.
