A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to provide that this state shall recognize
- 2 as marriage only the union of man and woman; to provide for submission of this amendment
- 3 for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Article I of the Constitution is amended by adding a new Section IV to read as follows:
- 7 "SECTION IV.
- 8 MARRIAGE
- 9 Paragraph I. *Recognition of marriage*. (a) This state shall recognize as marriage only the
- union of man and woman. Marriages between persons of the same sex are prohibited in this
- 11 state.

- 12 (b) No union between persons of the same sex shall be recognized by this state as entitled
- to the benefits of marriage. This state shall not give effect to any public act, record, or
- 14 judicial proceeding of any other state or jurisdiction respecting a relationship between
- persons of the same sex that is treated as a marriage under the laws of such other state or
- jurisdiction. The courts of this state shall have no jurisdiction to grant a divorce or separate
- maintenance with respect to any such relationship or otherwise to consider or rule on any
- of the parties' respective rights arising as a result of or in connection with such
- 19 relationship."
- SECTION 2.
- 21 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
- 22 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
- 23 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:

1 "() YES Shall the Constitution be amended so as to provide that this state shall

- 3 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
- 4 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
- 5 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
- 6 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
