2 WHEREAS, 4-H Clubs of Georgia provide a unique educational opportunity for students
3 from nine to 19 years of age to learn valuable lessons outside the classroom and offer some
4 55 project areas in which students can develop expertise and compete with one another; and

5 WHEREAS, Georgia's 4-H programs are coordinated by the Cooperative Extension Service
6 of the University of Georgia College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, and this
7 service is the major university outreach program focusing on the youth of this state; and

8 WHEREAS, Anna Daniel of Butts County is an outstanding member of 4-H and is the
9 recipient of the prestigious College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences Dean's
10 Project Award in Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, and she has also served with
11 distinction as a delegate to the 2003 national 4-H conference; and

12 WHEREAS, Anna Daniel is an outstanding representative of the dynamic resource this state
13 has in its young people.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
15 recognize and commend Anna Daniel as the recipient of the prestigious College of
16 Agricultural and Environmental Sciences Dean's Project Award in Agricultural and
17 Environmental Sciences and for this outstanding 4-H member's service as a delegate to the
18 national 4-H conference.
