#### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Natalie Smith; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the National 4-H Conference is designated as the premier assembly of 4-H  
3 members from throughout the nation to assist Cooperative Extension Service staff in program  
4 planning; and

5 WHEREAS, 4-H members serving as delegates provide specific recommendations for 4-H  
6 and Cooperative Extension Service programs at the county, state, and national levels; and
