A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

To amend Code Section 35-1-10 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to training in the investigation of family violence incidents, so as to provide for peace officer training in the investigation of sexual offense cases; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

Code Section 35-1-10 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to training in the investigation of family violence incidents, is amended by striking said Code section in its entirety and inserting in its place the following:

"35-1-10.

(a) The Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council and the Georgia Public Safety Training Center shall establish guidelines and procedures for the incorporation of training materials and information in:

(1) Methods ~~methods~~ for identifying, combating, and reporting family violence incidents; and

(2) Methods for identifying and reporting sexual offenses and assisting victims of sexual offenses.

(b) The guidelines and procedures listed in subsection (a) of this Code section shall be for use by law enforcement training centers monitored by the Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council and monitored and funded by the Georgia Public Safety Training Center in all courses for which they have responsibility and oversight."

SECTION 2.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
